Thank you to the church family for the prayers offered for the Mexico Mission Team. After an almost three-year absence, it was good to return to Mexico. The trip was a great success in many ways. Though our ministry was different from that in previous years, the team made a difference in discipling and teaching the Word of God. We deeply appreciate the prayers and resources given to help make the trip a success.

Read Georgia is our initiative to partner with Allen Elementary to assist children in developing their reading skills. It is time to volunteer. There is an insert in the Beacon for the church family to use for volunteering. This initiative begins toward the end of August, so it is time to prepare. Please sign up to assist with this vital ministry.

The **Quarterly Church Conference** will be August 14 at 5:00 that evening. This conference will be important as the Nominating Team brings its first report. The deacon body also will bring a recommendation and a calendar to the church body as it relates to the remainder of 2022. Jimmy Blanton will be recommended to the church body to serve as the transitional leader as the church moves forward in preparing to call a new pastor.

As part of the Transitional Ministry, there will be **listening sessions** on August 21 and 28. These meetings are designed to provide the church family the opportunity to speak into the life of the church with the transitional leader. You will be asked to sign up for a specific time on Sunday the 21st or 28th. Families with last name beginning with A – H are asked to sign up for the 21st from 2:00 – 4:00; J – Q are asked to sign up on the 28th from 2:00 – 4:00, R – Z are asked to sign up on the 28th from 5:00 – 7:00. A sign-up sheet will begin to circulate on August 1.

So that the church family will know of all critical dates, the **Nominating Team** is preparing the recommendations that will be decided on September 11 for the Transitional Search Team. This team will consist of nine persons; two will be alternates. All will be trained by Jimmy Blanton, our transitional leader in order to begin the search for a new pastor. It is vital that our membership begin to pray now for the election of this team in September.

May God's grace and love be yours throughout this week. May the Holy Spirit empower each of us to share the gospel and to strengthen the body of Christ.
