From the Pastor's Heart

As we move deeper into the Transitional Time, Brother Jimmy Blanton is preparing for the **Church Memories Workshop** on Sunday, October 9, from 3:00-5:30 in the Fellowship Hall for the church Family. The **Church Memories Workshop** will provide an opportunity for an interactive review of our past to determine both positive and negative effects the church's collective memory has on the present nature and ministry of the church. The focus of the process is to view the church's history through the eyes of Christ. During the workshop, participants will discover both the dynamic and the dysfunctional qualities in our church's past. Fourth, please spend time in the Word and ask the Lord to prepare your heart for worship. Fifth, please make every effort to be ready for the Lord to work.

May the Lord be exalted and honored as we walk with Him this week. May our hearts be filled moment by moment with the Holy Spirit.
